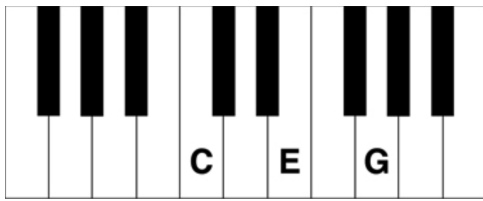
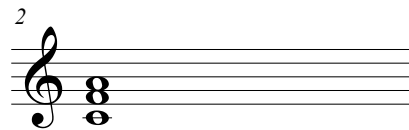
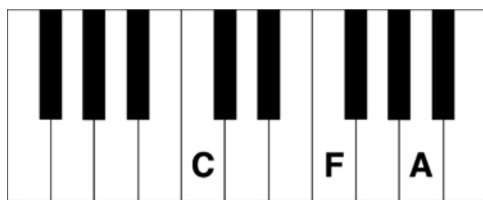


Easy Chord Progression

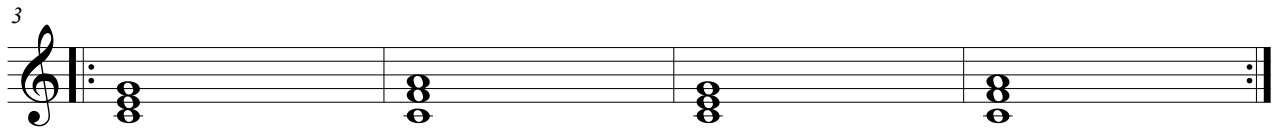
Lets try a super easy chord progression that uses very little hand movement. The first chord we will learn is the C chord and is shown on the keyboard below followed by the notes written on the staff.



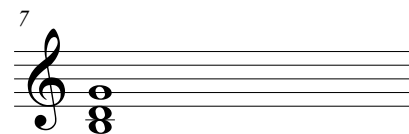
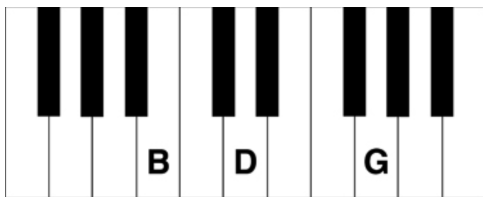
The next chord we will try is the F chord as shown below. Notice that we are still using the C note and fingers 3 and 5 moved up one note each.



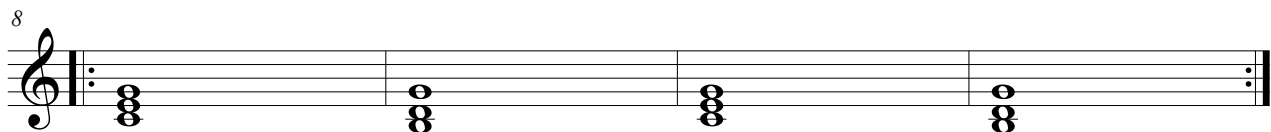
Now practice going from the C chord to the F chord. Repeat several time to get good at it.



The next chord we will learn is the G chord. Notice we are using another note common to the C chord and that is the note G. This time fingers 1 and 3 move down one note each.



Lets try moving from the C chord to the G chord.



The ultimate challenge now is to combine all the chords into one chord progression.
